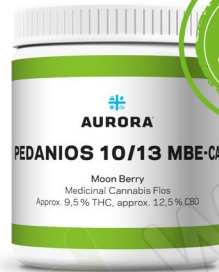

### Strain description:

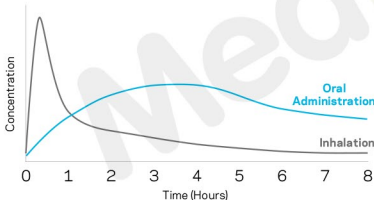
This premium strain with a balanced ratio of THC to CBD is characterised by a delightful aroma of berries, cream, and lemon. The main terpenes,  $\beta$ -myrcene and  $\alpha$ -pinene have analgesic, anti-inflammatory, and relaxing properties, and may have a beneficial impact on symptoms such as sleep disorders, stress, and depression.<sup>1</sup> Moon Berry is a great choice for those looking for a full-flavoured experience and the therapeutic benefits of moderate THC and balanced CBD.

### Inhalation:







Onset: after 2 – 8 min  
Peak effect: after 10 – 30 min  
Duration: 2 – 6 h

Using a vaporiser is a very efficient, fast-acting, and medically recommended form of administration. The optimal temperature setting is between 175 and 210°C.

## TITRATION GUIDE

- There is currently no uniform starting dose for cannabis products nor uniform dosing information.
- The recommended starting dose should be 0.05 g of flower. This corresponds to approx. 5 mg of THC and 6,5 mg of CBD in the PEDANIOS 10/13 variety. The dose can be increased by 0.1 g of flower every 1 - 3 days depending on efficacy and tolerance.<sup>3</sup>

<b>Onset of Effect</b>	 Within seconds to minutes	 Within 30 minutes to 2 hours
<b>Peak Effects</b>	 Full effects peak within 30 minutes	 Full effects peak within 4 hours
<b>Duration of Effect</b>	 Up to 6 hours or longer	 Up to 12 hours or longer
